Veterans Day at the Exchange Headquarters

Five hundred red, white and blue American flags are waving majestically in the front lawn of The National Exchange Club headquarters in Toledo, Ohio. The flags, representing more than 25 million veterans, will be flying from the morning of Saturday, November 8th, through Veterans Day on Tuesday, the 11th. This display of flags is known as the Healing Field and was inspired by the 9/11 memorial of the same name.

Volunteers began setting up the 3x5 foot flags on 8-foot poles

on Friday, November 7, at 4 p.m. Each of the 500 flags used in the display will be available for purchase (\$25). All proceeds from the sale of the flags will be donated to The Exchange Club Center for the Prevention of Child Abuse of Northwest Ohio.
